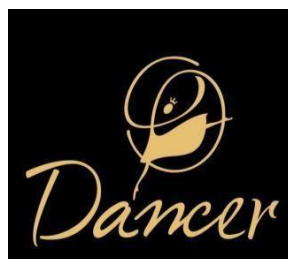

THE PURPOSE OF THE CONTEST

The contest aspires to award the talent of the young artists giving them the opportunity:

- to participate in the International Contest in "Royal Dance Grand Prix" in Italy and in China;
- offering scholarships in prestigious European and Chinese dance academies;
- offering Job contracts within dance in China and in Europe.

OBJECTIVES

- To promote the beauty of our country in all its forms to the public within the background of the foreign performances;
- To represent the collective artistic progress of dance groups, to award an unique possibility of exchange of experiences between dance groups, organizers and professors;
- To identify and support the performers and talented groups;
- To increase professionalism between both adults and young people;
- To establish a friendly international connection between the participating countries;
- To diffuse propaganda of the various forms of the art of choreography.

RULES

REGULATIONS DANCE CATEGORIES

1. Classical dance
2. Modern dance
3. Character dance.

AGE CATEGORIES

Group A/0: from 6 to 10 years old:

Soloists – variation of maximum 1:30 minutes.

For groups with not more than 9 members, the maximum time of exhibition is 3:30 minutes.

For groups with more than 10 members, the maximum time allowed is 5 minutes.

Group A: from 11 to 13 years old:

Soloists – variation of maximum 1:30 minutes.

For groups with not more than 9 members, the maximum time of exhibition is 3:30 minutes.

For groups with more than 10 members, the maximum time allowed is 5 minutes.

Group B (juniors): from 14 to 17 years old:

Soloists – variation of maximum 1:30 minutes.

For groups with not more than 9 members, the maximum time of exhibition is 3:30 minutes.

For groups with more than 10 members, the maximum time allowed is 5 minutes.

Group C (juniors 2): from 18 to 20 years old:

Soloists – variation of maximum 1:45 minutes.

For groups with not more than 9 members, the maximum time of exhibition is 3:30 minutes.

For groups with more than 10 members, the maximum time allowed is 5 minutes.

Group D (seniors): from 21 to 35 years old:

Soloists – variation of maximum 2 minutes.

For groups with not more than 9 members, the maximum time of exhibition is 3:30 minutes.

For groups with more than 10 members, the maximum time allowed is 5 minutes.

Group E (pas de deux):

E(1) from 11 to 13 years old

E(2) from 14 to 17 years old

E(3) from 18 to 35 years old

The time of a choreography is between 2 and 3 minutes.

THE JURY

The Jury of the contest is formed by the best specialists in international choreography and by representatives of the organizing associations .

EVALUATION CRITERIA

- Technique;
- Coherence of the choreography's style;
- Artistry and interpretation;
- Correspondence between the musical and choreographic parts;
- The scenic presence.

The exhibitions will be judged on a scale between 1 and 10. Each participant has the right to take the jury protocols' results.

PRIZES OF THE INTERNATIONAL CONTEST "ROYAL BALTIC DANCE COMPETITION"

RIGA, 6 – 7 APRIL 2019

For the Winner/Winners selected in the categories B, C, D, and E of any dance category:

- The right to participate in the international contest "Royal Dance Grand Prix" in July 2019 in China and Access to the "Beijing dancer culture and art development Co" in order to benefit from the scholarship of 2 or 10 months, the monthly pocket money of 500 Euros and paid accommodation. The visa release process is undertaken by the organization.

For the Winner/Winners selected among the first classified of each age and dance category:

- The right to participate in the international contest "Royal Dance Grand Prix" in Italy, travel and accommodation expenses covered.
- In the case of a child under 16 years of age, the

presence of an accompanying adult is compulsory. The adult's accommodation in Italy will be covered partially by the organization, but not the travel expenses.

The award from the founders of the association to the choreographer for the most exciting choreography of the soloist or group: participation in the jury of Italian RDGP (travel and accommodation expenses covered).

The members of the Jury who are also ballet companies' or ballet schools' directors will be able, regardless of the classification, to offer scholarships or theatrical practice or professional work contracts in the Dance industry in China and in Europe.

The organization takes the right to assign, regardless of the classification : - Certificate of qualification with the right to free registration fee to participate in the "Royal Dance Grand Prix" next edition in Italy .

MODE OF ENROLMENT

The participants can be soloists, pas de deux couples and groups, both students and artists of private or professional schools or theatres.

The participants can compete in more than one dance category, sending a separate application form for each category.

The application forms for the participants must be completed and sent to the e-mail: royals.line@yahoo.it .

APPLICATION FEE

Soloists – 50 Euros (for 2 Performances)

Pas de deux – 20 Euros for each member, in one category a performance.

Groups - 10 Euros for each member (for 2 Performances)

The fee for the application must be paid to the "Royal's Line Group" Association account, mentioned at the bottom of this regulation, not later than 1 March, 2019.

Paying the registration fee before 1 February 2019, the participant has the right to the 10% discount from full registration.

THE ONES SELECTED TO TAKE PART IN THE CONTEST RDGP IN RIGA WILL HAVE TO OBLIGE TO THE FOLLOWING TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS:

It is compulsory to send the music for the exhibition to e-mail: royals.line@yahoo.it

Each participant must bring the audio recording memorized on a CD with an optimal sound quality with the following information: name, surname, dance category, name and duration of the show.

ATTENTION!

The organizers will have the right to use and share (without any cost) the audio, video and photographic material of the participants, together with recordings, paper work and other material obtained during the contest.

It is possible to modify the application form before 1 April 2019.

The stage is without inclination with the professional carpet.

ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE PARTICIPANTS AND ACCOMPANYING PERSONS WHO NEED ACCOMMODATION:

3 stars Hotel X 1 day X 1 person – from 30 Euros (in single room)

3 stars Hotel X 1 day X 1 person – from 20 Euros (in double room)

4 stars Hotel X 1 day X 1 person – from 40 Euros (in single room)

4 stars Hotel X 1 day X 1 person – from 25 Euros (in double room)

In order to book the rooms, it is necessary to anticipate 50% of the accommodation expenses. The payment must be settled not later than 1 March 2019. The remaining 50% (regarding accommodation) must be paid at your arrival.
